The August 2012 ECF grading list will be used. Players not in possession of a current grade should state their last published grade and the year to which it applied. Players with no official grading must give an estimate of their playing strength with evidence or a reference by a known player.

Written notice must be received by 13th October 2012. A deduction of £5 will be made to cover administration costs. No refunds will be given for withdrawals after this date

A half-point bye will be accepted in any round if requested on the entry form. We reserve the right to move players into other sections should a particular tournament become full (grades permitting) however every effort will be made to honour a player's choice.
